Public Hearing Site Plan Review Application # 10 – Bunce:

and Michael Bunce. Acting Chairman Poelker reads the Public Hearing Notice. Greene and White Certified Return Receipts are turned in. The property is in the Norman G Bunce Revocable Trust which John Bunce is the executer. John Bunce is discussing With Supervisor Hoyt as to what is the best way to hooked up to the sewer, as well as DOT for the driveway. DOT advised that they need Site Plan approval from the Planning Board before they will come to look at the driveway. Member Jaeger makes a motion to close the Public Hearing, 2nd by Member Lane, 4 in favor, 1 absent, 2 vacancies. Acting Chairman Poelker reads through the Short EAF Form part 2 and 3. Member Jaeger makes a motion to approve the Plans as presented, 2nd Member Lane, 4 in favor, 1 absent, 2 vacancies.

Acting Chairman Poelker opens the floor for comments. Pat Madigan is here and has a few questions for the Planning Board regarding the property on Mitchell Hollow Road, Tax Map # 61.00-2-48, Woods Subdivision. Pat wants to know if there will be a survey to check the electrical lines, are they high enough, etc? Acting Chairman Poelker explains that the County takes all that into account when they do their survey. Pat also states that at the last Planning Board Meeting Sept 17, 2020) they discussed that they would be drilling 5 wells. Acting Chairman Poelker states that it is a 5 lot subdivision, so yes there will be 5 wells. Pat wants to let the Planning Board know that there is a well already there. He does not know if it is good or not, but its been there for awhile. Acting Chairman Poelker says that if they are going to use that well it will have to be tested. Pat says that it may be useable without having to drill another well. Member Jaeger

states that you are talking about the lot it's self, which is 14 acres so 5 wells in 14 acres is plenty of room. We will note it in out Minutes tonight.
