WAGE SCHEDULE FOR POSTION/APPOINTMENT: The following rates were approved: **Temporary Clerical Help** will be at minimum wage of **\$15.00 per hour**. A motion to approve was made by Councilman Peters, 2nd by Councilman Walker, with all in favor. **Clerical Help**part time position-20 hours per week will be at a minimum wage of **\$15.00 per hour**. A motion to approve was made by Councilman Peters, 2nd by Councilman Van Valin, with all in favor. **Account Clerk/Clerk to Main Office (Bette Rhoades)** pay will increase from \$21.00 per hour to **\$21.50 per hour** as a full-time position-40 hours per week. A motion to approve was made by Councilman Peters, 2nd by Councilman Goettsche, with all in favor. **Bookkeeper to the Supervisor (Cynthia Nelson)** pay will increase from \$22.70 per hour to **\$23.15 per hour** as a full-time position-40 hours per week. The current union contract in place has no employee wages stated for 2023. Labor Attorney Elayne Gold and the Union Lawyer will need to review the contract and make the correction for 2023 with a 2% increase on wages. The Highway Employees will receive retro pay back to 01/01/2023 once the wages for 2023 have been established. A motion to approve once wages are set and retro pay back the new wages was made by Councilman Peters, 2nd by Supervisor Hoyt, with all in favor. The Highway Dept. Labor/Wingman/Sidewalk Maintenance are paid \$15.00 per hour for a part time-20 hours per week position as needed work to be done.

Board of Assessment Review Members will remain at **\$80.00 per session**. A motion to approve was made by Supervisor Hoyt, 2nd by Councilman Peters, with all in favor. **Planning Board Chairman** pay will remain at **\$65.00 per session**. Ambulance Driver on Call will remain at \$36.00. Ambulance Driver per Hour will increase from \$14.05 per hour to \$15.00 per hour. EMT on Call will remain at \$46.00. EMT per Hour will increase from \$18.00 per hour to \$18.50 per hour. AEMT- Intermediate on Call will AEMT- Intermediate per Hour will increase from \$19.08 per hour to remain at **\$46.00**. \$19.50 per hour. Paramedic on Call will remain at \$56.00. Paramedic per Hour will increase from \$22.63 per hour to \$23.25 per hour. A motion to approve was made by Supervisor Hoyt, 2nd by Councilman Peters, with all in favor. Ambulance Administrator Davia Montie is appointed to a full-time position as a Paramedic with the Ambulance Administrator responsibilities; and she will need to cover two 12-hour shifts as a Paramedic on the ambulance. Her pay will be \$55,000 annual salary. A motion to approve was made by Supervisor Hoyt, 2nd by Councilman Peters, with all in favor. Full time Paramedic-Daniel Lendin will increase from \$22.63 per hour to \$23.25 per hour. A motion to approve was made by Supervisor Hoyt, 2nd by Councilman Peters, with all in favor. **Full time EMT-James Stone** will increase from \$18.00 per hour to **\$18.50 per hour**. A motion to approve was made by Supervisor Hoyt, 2nd by Councilman Peters, with all in favor. Quality Improvement Coordinator - Christopher Maeurer (position created 1/01/18) to assist Ambulance Administrator Davia Montie. His pay will be \$1,000 stipend at the end of the year. A motion to approve stipend to stay the same was made by Supervisor Hoyt, 2nd by Councilman Peters, with all in favor.

The Board would like to change this policy **effective January 1, 2023 for a zero-day waiting period**, the new hire full-time (40-hours) employee could now receive health insurance, dental insurance and eye vision insurance immediately. A motion to approve was made by Councilman Peters, 2nd by Councilman Goettsche, with all in favor.
