1.DELAWARE ENGINEERING: John Brust was not present.

<u>2.WATER SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:</u> Water Superintendent Kyle Schwarz was not present. President Hoyt reported that there has been a water leak that was recently found. The system was losing thousands and thousands of gallons. It is at an existing business that is under construction. The water was never initially shut off. The basement and all the lines running to this existing building have now all frozen and broke. The water bill will be emissive.

3.APPLICATION FOR OUT OF DISTRICT TOWN WATER SERVICE: Lori & Guido Aceto, 95 Mill Street, Windham, Tax Map #78.00-5-45.1; for proposed lots 1 & 2 (pending subdivision). The property owners are requesting 2 EDUs for single family residence. A \$50.00 application process fee has been submitted for each proposed lot. A meter with an outside reader is required on all accounts. A motion to approve was made by Commissioner Van Valin, 2nd by Commissioner Peters, with all in favor.
